STAGE II Business Incubation

- 6 Month coaching by EIT Food core partner
- Mobility Grants (2K)
- Final Pitch Competition with prizes up to 10K

6 Month Mentoring

Monthly, one-on-one coaching from **July to December** by one EIT Food partner, on commercialization of business ideas
