### WHAT IS SERVICE-LEARNING?

S-L represents an experiential and education methodology combining learning and community service in a single project with a civic and academic basis.

### WHAT'S THE CONTENT OF THE INTERNSHIP?

In case you are selected you will be asked to contribute to the development of different activities programed during ongoing S-L projects related with Fire Management with the support of different stakeholders (companies, forest owner associations, administrators, researchers).


### WHAT SKILLS ARE DEVELOPED?

The stays will contribute to student training, further developing transversal and employability skills, confidence and capability for teamwork in an international and multi-disciplinary setting.









## **Activities during the internship**

#### FIELD ACTIVITIES

- Field trips to critically damaged areas, detection of fire risk perception, interviews with stakeholders to understand possible solutions.
- Fire prevention, through the design and execution of preventive forestry activities (clearing, pruning, thinning, preventive cuts), the location and revision of preventive infrastructures.
- **Emergency management** activities: for small fires, students can join a forest brigade.

### LAB/TECHNICAL ACTIVITIES

- Development of wildfire risk maps, stakeholder's maps, data processing and conversion.
- Provide support on **research** around forest fire causes.

### **AUDIOVISUAL CONTENT DEVELOPMENT**

 Development of "knowledge pills" through photo/video materials. The idea is to create short videos or a short documentary with the most relevant information about the experience.

### **EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES**

 Service-Learning Project design: preparation of a technical educational project, support in the drafting of the reforestation project to be carried out in autumn-winter.
