Description

During her stay at DICUS, Prof. Maria Inés Mangione will deliver a 12 hours Course entitled: "An Introduction to Green Chemistry: Bridging Organic Chemistry with Sustainable Practices" for the PhD Course in Chemical Science, and specifically she will analyse the following topics:

Introduction to Organic Chemistry and Green Chemistry. Organic Reactions and Green Optimization. Catalysis and Sustainable Materials. Industrial Applications and the Future of Green Chemistry

Moreover, she will also give a Seminar at DICUS dealing with the most recent results of the researches carried out by her group in Argentina. Title of the Seminar: "Valorization of cellulose-derived compounds: a novel pathway to bioactive derivatives".

During her stay at the Department of Chemistry she will have the opportunity to discuss with Post-Doctoral Students and PhD students of the Department. The PhD students will have the opportunity to solve doubts and discuss on their respective research projects.
